The Museum traces its roots back to 1892, the year the McLean County Historical Society was founded. Today, the McLean County Museum of History features seven exhibit galleries, over 18,000 objects in its collections, a library of nearly 10,000 volumes and over 1,500 linear feet of archives. The museum also offers many hands-on activities for children, educational programming and annual events including the Evergreen Cemetery Discovery Walk and Christmas at the Courthouse.

This elegant, 36 room estate of Judge David Davis was completed in 1872 and is a model of mid-Victorian style and taste with Italianate and Second Empire architectural features. Davis, friend and mentor to Abraham Lincoln,



served as a United States Supreme Court Justice and was a key contributor during Lincoln's bid for the 1860 Presidential nomination. His Bloomington home, which remained in the Davis family for three succeeding generations, provided a focal point for the social, cultural and political life of the community. The estate offers tours for both groups and individuals. Arrangements can also be made for a special Tea Ladies program at the Mansion.

Ewing Cultural Center, the estate of the late Hazle Buck Ewing, is a community landmark that includes Ewing Manor, the Genevieve Green Gardens and the Theatre at Ewing which hosts the annual Illinois Shakespeare Festival. The Channel-Norman style Manor, built in 1929, serves as an event venue and hosts meetings, retreats and private events. The Manor is open for walk-in guided tours on the third Wednesday of each month at 10:00AM, 12:00PM and 2:00PM. Scheduled group tours may be arranged for a fee. The tour includes climbing flights of stairs to and from three levels.

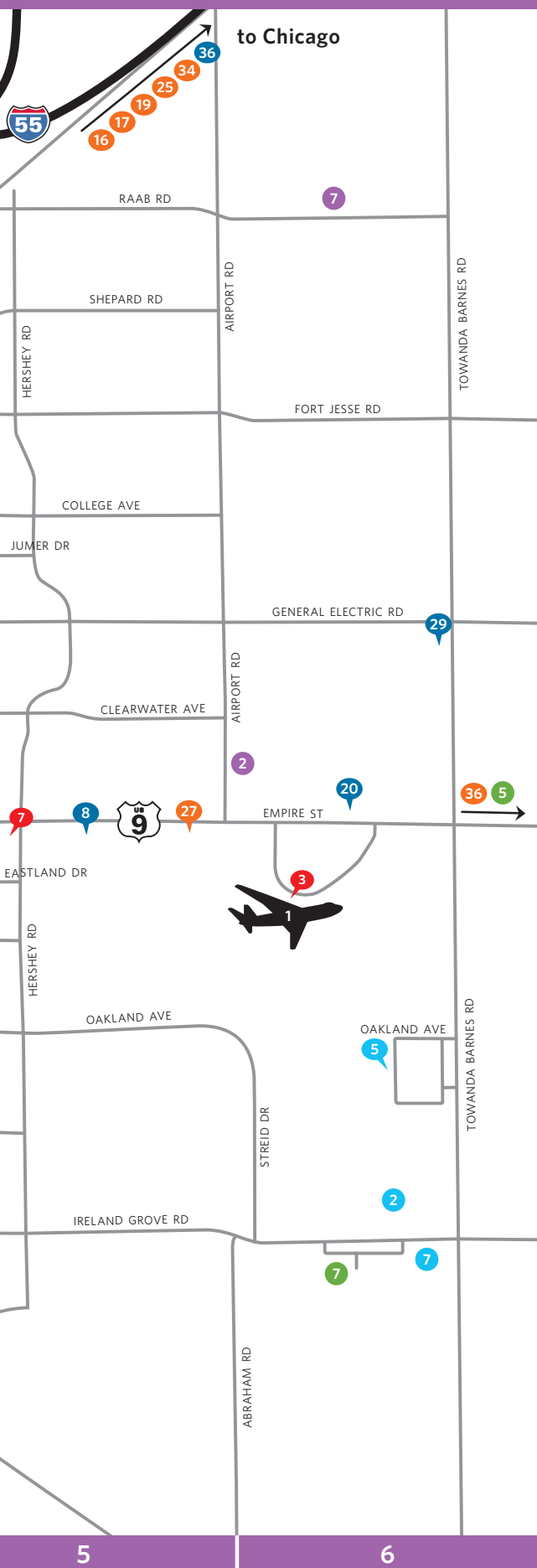
